## BY-LAW 11-2022

## Being a By-law to appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer

WHEREAS Part XIV, Section 425 of the Ontario Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 provides for the enforcement of the by-laws of the municipality,

AND WHEREAS the Building Code Act, S.O. Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, Section 3 provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass a By-law to appoint such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, section 15 (1) provides that a Council of a Municipality may appoint persons to enforce By-laws of the Municipality and that they be deemed peace officers for the purpose of enforcing Municipal By-laws;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of South River deems it desirable to appoint a person to enforce the Municipal By-laws;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of South River hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Braden Bradford be hereby appointed the Municipal Law Enforcement Official of the Corporation of the Village of South River.
- 2. The terms of employment are as per attached Schedule "A"
- 3. That By-law #46-2015 be repealed in it's entirety.
- 4. This By-law shall come into force and be effective from the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2022.
