

Request for Quote (RFQ): Accessible Walking/Cycling Path Design, Drawings and Tender Package

Project Overview

The Village of South River is seeking quotes for the design, engineered drawings, cost estimates, and a tender ready construction package for a 650-metre long by 3-metre wide walking/cycling path built to meet or exceed Accessibility for Ontarians with Disability Act standards. The project is envisioned to include grubbing to a depth of 200mm, supplying and compacting a Granular A base to 150mm depth, and supplying and placing a 50mm thick pavement over a 1950 square metre area. Additionally, the project requires the design of appropriate access and wayfinding signage and lighting along the path. Currently approximately 150 metres of the trail has heavy tree coverage and 450 metres has an existing loose stone path. See maps attached for location.

Project Details as Envisioned – proponents are encouraged to propose positive alternatives

- Path Dimensions:
 - Length: 650 metresWidth: 3 metres
- Scope of Work to be designed and costed
- 1. Grubbing:
- Clearing the designated area to a depth of 200mm. Approximately 150 metres is tree covered and 450 metres a cleared gravel trail. See map attached
- 2. Granular A Base:
 - Supply and compact a Granular A base to a depth of 150mm.
- 3. Pavement Installation:
 - Supply and place a 50mm thick pavement over a 1950 square metre area.
- 4. Signage and Lighting:
 - Appropriate signage at access points and along the walking/cycling path.
 - Suitable lighting to enhance safety and visibility.

Quote Submission Guidelines

Interested parties are invited to submit detailed quotes addressing the following:

- 1. Company Information:
 - Name of the company
 - Contact person and contact details
 - Relevant experience in similar projects
- 2. **Technical Approach:** the drawings will reflect
 - Detailed plan for grubbing, including equipment and methodology.
 - Specifications for the Granular A base, pavement, signage, and lighting materials.



• Construction methodology for the walking/cycling path and allowance for existing snowmobile trail, including signage and lighting installation.

3. Timeline:

• Proposed project timeline, including key milestones assuming design project to be awarded March 1, 2024.

4. Cost Estimate: will reflect

- Detailed cost breakdown for each component of the project, including signage and lighting.
- Any potential additional costs or contingencies.

5. References:

 Contact information for at least two references from previous projects of a similar nature.

- References from previous clients.




