

BY-LAW 11-2022

Being a By-law to appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer

WHEREAS Part XIV, Section 425 of the Ontario Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 provides for the enforcement of the by-laws of the municipality,

AND WHEREAS the Building Code Act, S.O. Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, Section 3 provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass a By-law to appoint such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, section 15 (1) provides that a Council of a Municipality may appoint persons to enforce By-laws of the Municipality and that they be deemed peace officers for the purpose of enforcing Municipal By-laws;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of South River deems it desirable to appoint a person to enforce the Municipal By-laws;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of South River hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Braden Bradford be hereby appointed the Municipal Law Enforcement Official of the Corporation of the Village of South River.
2. The terms of employment are as per attached Schedule "A"
3. That By-law #46-2015 be repealed in it's entirety.
4. This By-law shall come into force and be effective from the 28th day of March, 2022.
