What's Happening in South River During COVID-19?

Be sure to check our website and Facebook for ongoing updates about COVID and how it is affecting our community.

The Municipal Office is currently closed to the public. However, we look forward to being able to see you again. Keep watching the website or Facebook for reopening details. In the meantime call the office to book an appointment if you need us in person. Council and staff will continue to monitor the situation in order to protect residents and staff.

Although the municipal office is not open to the public, you can still reach us by calling (705)386-2573. You can also make a payment using one of the following methods:

- **ONLINE:** this is the preferred method and can be completed with bank accounts from Kawartha Credit Union, Royal Bank, Scotia and TD. You must use a

separate payee for your taxes and water. When creating the payee, search "South River" and you must choose taxes or water accordingly. Your full roll number is the account number for both taxes and water. Please call if you need further assistance.

- **CHEQUE:** Make your cheque payable to the 'Village of South River' and mail it to the address above or place it in the drop box located at the front entrance of the municipal office.
- **CASH:** You can pay with cash only if you have the exact change **between 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. during regular business hours.** Place the payment in the drop box at the front entrance of the municipal office. **Do not pay with cash outside these times.**

encounters-bear-wise. When bears pick up a scent with their keen noses, they will investigate it. If they find bird food, garbage or pet food they will return as long as the food source is available.

Here are a few reminders: put garbage out only on the morning of

garbage day, not the night before; put garbage in containers that have tight-fitting lids and store it in a bear-proof location such as your basement or a sturdy garage; spray garbage cans and lids with bleach or another strong disinfectant; do not leave pet food outdoors, in screened-in areas or porches.

Please **support local businesses** when you can. They support our community year round and now would be a great time to return the favour when you have the opportunity.

Statutory Holiday Hours: Municipal staff will not be answering inquiries on Wednesday, July 1st and Monday, August 3rd.
