Fall compost pick-up will take place on Mondays for the month of October, except for the holiday Monday. Pick-up will be offered on Tuesday, October 11th in lieu of Thanksgiving Monday. Please use paper leaf

bags instead of plastic bags. Plastic bags will NOT be picked up. When putting out branches, please bundle them into manageable lengths.

The next Large Item Pick-up will take place on Monday, November 1st. Remember no automotive, steel or hazmat items. All items must be registered by calling the municipal office no later than 4 p.m. on

Wednesday, October 27th @ 386-2573.

# Funding for Watermain Project

The Village of South River is pleased to announce the South River Watermain Rehabilitation is being funded under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program – Green Stream by the Government of Canada and Province of Ontario.

This \$2,695,000 project will replace two kilometres of deteriorated cast iron watermains with 8-inch PVC piping and the rehabilitation of the road surface and sidewalks.

The project is funded \$1,049,760 by Federal funds, \$874,713 Provincial funding and \$699,927 from the Village of South River. We look forward to having the work completed by the fall of 2022

## Preparing For The Coming Seasons

This is a good time to ensure your outdoor faucet is in good working order or if you don't have one, perhaps you should consider installing one. In recent years, some residents have experienced frozen water pipes. A properly working outdoor faucet can be used when necessary to maintain a steady flow of water to prevent water pipes from freezing.

Residents are responsible for their own plumbing which includes the line from the curb stop to your house.

Additional seasonal suggestions include:

- ◆Clean and inspect your chimney each year.
- ◆Heating systems should be inspected annually by a qualified technician.

- ◆Install a carbon monoxide alarm in your home.
- ♦ Give heaters space, keep them away from anything flammable.
- ♦ Use a fire screen around a fire place.
- ◆Allow ashes to cool from a woodstove before putting them in a steel container with a tight fitting lid.
- ◆Change the batteries in your smoke alarms when you change your clocks.
