## What You Need To Know Before The Snow Arrives

The Village of South River has a policy to define and explain snow clearing and ice control which is available for viewing on the municipal website under the 'Policy' tab or at the municipal office, please take time to read it.

- \* *Windrows of snow plowed across private approaches and/or walks and resulting from street plowing or sidewalk clearing shall not be removed by the municipality.*
- \* *It is suggested to pile snow on the right side of your driveway (when*

*facing the road) when shoveling. This helps minimize the ridge of snow created by the snowplow at the end of your driveway.*

When you are shoveling or blowing snow, it's a good idea to make a plan. Push your snow banks back now to make room for the snow that will come later.

***\*It is illegal and unsafe to deposit snow or ice onto a roadway. DO NOT push snow across the road when shoveling your driveway.*** (Ontario Highway Traffic Act, Deposit of snow on roadway 18.1)

Remember no person shall park any vehicle on any highway, boardwalk or sidewalk under the jurisdiction of the Village between the hours of 12 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. from November 01 of each year to April 30 of the following year. Contravention of this section of the by-law may result in the vehicle being towed and impounded at the expense of the owner. Read the parking by-law 34-2016 in full for more details. The by-law is available on our website or can be viewed at the municipal office during regular business hours.

Payments can be made through online banking with TD, Scotiabank, RBC and Kawartha Credit Union. We also accept cash, cheque and debit at the front counter in the office. We accept E-transfers for payments as well to accounts@southriver.ca, Please be sure to state what the payment is for and your roll number or street address, if we don't know what it is for or where to apply it, we can not process the payment. Remember when paying online, if you pay after 6:00pm we will not receive it until 2 days later (Example Wednesday at 7:00 pm payment made, we will not receive it until Friday) payment could be late

## 2023 Taxes

The second installment of the 2023 Final tax bill is due by November 30, 2023

Interest on past due amounts is run on the first day of default. Interest is only added to the principal amount owing. If you had arrears showing on your

final bill, please verify the amount owing when making payment to determine any amount of interest that may have been charged after the bills were printed.

Payments can be made online with Kawartha Credit Union, RBC, TD,

Scotiabank or EFT. Please remember it takes a couple of days for your online payment to reach the municipal office.

Debit, cash & cheque payments can be made in the office. Keep all your receipts. There is a fee of \$25 for additional copies or tax profiles.
