Village Construction Updates

As you are probably aware, We have lots of improvements happening around the Village. We have 2 separate construction projects happening doing the same work. The return of the Watermain Rehabilitation Project Phase 1 and Phase 2 ensues with Working Hours: Monday to Thursday 7:00 am - 6:00 pm Fridays 7:00 am -3:00 pm Scope: Removal and Replacement of Water main and Services, Fire Hydrants, Curbs, Sidewalks, and Asphalt Paving. Please be patient and co-operate with workers if they come to your door. Temporary water service lines will be installed, roads will be blocked or closed for short amounts of time, and unfortunately at times boil water advisories may happen.

We do thank you for your patience and co-operation.

Code Red

If you haven't already done so, take a moment to sign up for *Code Red*. Code Red can inform you about local emergency situations, water related priorities such as boil water advisories or water conservation requirements, etc.

When a Code Red message is sent, those who have signed up for the service receive the message instantly. In order to receive these messages, you must sign-up for the service. Call the South River—Machar Fire Department @ (705)386-0066 for more information or to sign-up. You can also sign-up online at www.srmfd.com. When you receive a Code Red message, it will come from a 1-855 phone number, don't mistake it for a telemarketer. Please visit the Village of South River's website at southriver.ca for a checklist of items that should be in your 72 hour emergency kits and more information on emergency preparation and planning.

By-Law Brief

As the summer season begins, the Bylaw Enforcement Department would like to remind residents that the keeping of backyard hens is regulated by Bylaw 49-2022. Owners of hens must apply for a licence and complete a site inspection prior to purchasing or keeping hens on their property. The maximum number of hens permitted is 6.

Waste & Recycling Information

Garbage is to be at the curb no later than 8 am every Friday. Recycling saves us all money, it also cuts back on the amount of garbage a household produces, as we have a **2 bag limit weekly**. Recycling saves our landfills from filling up too fast. Recycling bins can be purchased at the local hardware store, it doesn't have to be green/blue. Just be sure to put out the proper stuff on the appropriate week, a recycling calendar is available at the office or on our website <u>southriver.ca</u>

Cardboard is to be broken down and tied with string into manageable lengths, if it does not fit in your recycling box, failure to do this could result in your cardboard not being picked up, if you have more than 2 bags of garbage the driver will not take it.

If you do not have a garbage can to put your garbage in but are concerned about the birds or animals getting into it and ripping the bags put a blanket over it. If birds/animals do rip your garbage apart, **please clean it up** so it doesn't blow into your neighbours yard or into the ditches for others to clean up, lets work together to keep our

Village clean and tidy.

Have you been unable to pay Your Taxes & Water....

If you have fallen behind on your tax or water account and are not sure how you can get caught up, please call us. We will work with you on a payment plan to get you back on track. Interest is run for taxes on the first of every month, water interest is run on

the 16th of the month or the next business day. If property taxes reach 3rd year arrears it will be sent for tax sale. The process is very expensive and gets added to your tax account. Disconnection water notices will be mailed once your account is over \$250.
