Waste & Recycling Information

Seasonal Compost Collection is scheduled to take place on May 1st, 8th, 15th, 23rd and 29th. This service is for the collection of lawn rakings, leaves and small bundles of brush and twigs. Bagged compost must be in paper bags. Plastic bags will NOT be accepted. Brush must be cut into 4' lengths and tied into manageable bundles. This service is provided by municipal staff and may be delayed due to circumstances beyond the control of the village i.e. (weather, unplanned water distribution maintenance, emergencies, etc.) You may also want to consider composting your lawn rakings for future use. Hazmat Drop Off is available during designated times at the Strong Landfill Site #1, 483 Forest Lake Road. Scheduled dates for this service are May 27 & August 26, 2023 10 AM-2 PM. North Bay's Household Hazardous Waste Program accepts various hazardous waste products please visit www.northbay.ca for more information.

The garbage bag limit is 2 per household/unit and have your waste and recycling out to the curb no later than 8:00 AM

Have you been unable to pay Your Taxes & Water....

If you have fallen behind on your tax or water account and are not sure how you can get caught up, please call us. We will work with you on a payment plan to get you back on track. Interest is run for taxes on the first of every month, water interest is run on

the 16th of the month or the next business day. If property taxes reach 3rd year arrears it will be sent for tax sale. The process is very expensive and gets added to your tax account. Disconnection notices will be mailed once your account is over \$250. A deposit could be added for delinquent accounts at a residential rate of \$300 and a none-residential rate of \$350. If we need to disconnect your water, a deposit will be required to turn it on, disconnection and reconnection fees will be charged.
