A completed nomination form, proof of identity, and a filing fee (\$200 for Mayor, \$100 for Councillor) are required at the time of submission.

If you care about your community and want to have a voice in its future, consider running for Council. Your perspective, ideas, and leadership can help make a lasting impact in South River.

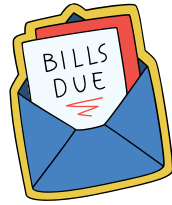

If you are experiencing any water issues please call the Village hours during office hours Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 4:30pm.

After hours contact Public Works at 705- 386-0245.

Did you know that it is the homeowners responsibility for anything to do with your water lines from the curb stop into your house, as well as the plumbing inside your home. Homeowners can check with their insurer for coverage as repairs are generally thousands of dollars.

Our Public Works crew like to help out our residents but they are not plumbers. We have some plumbers in the area who would be happy to assist you with your plumbing needs.

If you experience coloured water, Please let your cold water tap run (preferably an outside tap or laundry tub)until it clears, this should happen within about 10mins, discoloured water may occur if there is a disturbance in the water lines, such as if the fire department needs to access a fire hydrant or there is a break in the water lines. If your water doesn't come clean after 10 mins please contact us.

Seasonal Compost Collection is scheduled to take place on May 4th, 11th,19th and 25th. This service is for the collection of lawn rakings, leaves and small bundles of brush and twigs. Bagged compost must be in paper bags. Plastic bags will NOT be accepted.

Brush must cut into 4' lengths and tied into manageable bundles. This service is provided by municipal staff and may be delayed due to circumstances beyond control of the village i.e.

(weather, unplanned water distribution maintenance, emergencies, etc.) You may also want to consider composting your lawn rakings for future use.

North Bay's Household Hazardous Waste & Electronics Program accepts various hazardous waste products and electronics on a year round basis for Village of South River residents at 112 Patton St. North Bay, Wednesday to Saturday 8 AM to 6 PM. Dog Owners:

Help keep the Village of South River clean, safe, and enjoyable for everyone. When walking your dog, please ensure they are always kept on a leash and that you clean up after them—this simple step makes a big difference in maintaining our shared spaces. Failing to pick up after your dog can result in a \$150 fine. Additionally, all dogs within the Village must be registered. Lifetime dog tags are available for just \$30 and can be obtained at the Village office. Your cooperation helps create a responsible and welcoming community for residents and visitors alike.
