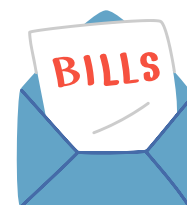

Good to Know

Fall compost pick-up will take place on Mondays for the month of October, except for the holiday Monday. Pickup will be offered on Tuesday, October 14th in lieu of Thanksgiving Monday. Please use paper leaf bags instead of plastic bags. Plastic bags will NOT be picked up. When putting out branches, please bundle them into manageable lengths.

This is a good time to ensure your outdoor faucet is in good working order or if you don't have one, perhaps you should consider installing one. In recent years, some residents have experienced frozen water pipes. A properly working outdoor faucet can be used when necessary to maintain a steady flow of water to prevent water pipes from freezing. Residents are responsible for their own plumbing which includes the line from the curb stop to your house. Additional seasonal suggestions include: "Clean and inspect your chimney each year." Heating systems should be inspected annually by a qualified technician. "Install a carbon monoxide alarm in your home." Give heaters space, keep them away from anything flammable. "Use a fire screen around a fire place." Allow ashes to cool from a woodstove before putting them in a steel container with a tight fitting lid. "Change the batteries in your smoke alarms when you change your clocks."

The last **Large Item Pick-up** for the year will take place on Friday November 6. Remember no automotive, steel or hazmat items. All items must be registered by calling the municipal office no later than 4 p.m. on Friday October 30 at 705-386-2573. Refer to the 2026 Waste & Recycling Calendar for more information. Fall flushing of the water mains for general maintenance is scheduled to take place **September 28 - October 2.**

Final tax bills have been mailed and available online.

The first installment of this bill will be due by September 29, 2026 and the second installment will be due by November 30, 2026. Keep all receipts issued by the municipality. There is a fee of \$30 to provide duplicate copies.

IMPORTANT:

As of January 1 2027 any property with outstanding 2025 property taxes can be registered for a tax sale. If you need a payment plan please reach out immediately.

Anyone with water bills 3 billing cycles behind can have the water disconnect without notice and subject to a disconnection and reconnection fee with a deposit plus paying the water bill in full to have your water reconnected.

Train Safety Reminder

With the return of the Ontario Northlander to the Village of South River, it's a great time to refresh our knowledge of railway safety. Always obey railway crossing signs and signals, never drive around lowered crossing gates, and only cross the tracks at designated crossings. Stay alert, avoid distractions near railway tracks, and remember that trains can approach quickly and require a long distance to stop. By-Law

If you have a comment/complaint about anything happening around the Village, you must fill out a comment/complaint form and submit it to the office either by email or bring it in, without a written copy nothing can be done to rectify a situation, if it's not in writing it didn't happen! Forms can be found on our website or by coming into the office. It is up to the owners of pets, dogs, cats, and chickens, within the Village to abide by the noise by-law and not disturb your neighbours. Hen license is required to have hens.
