

South River Machar Arena and Community Centre PROOF OF VACCINATION POLICY

All patrons entering the facility are required to provide proof of identification and proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID 19. This is as per the provincial restrictions outlined in section 2.1 of Schedule 1 of [O.Reg.364/20: Rules for Areas at Step 3 and at the Roadmap Exit Step](#).

Should an individual choose not to share this information, then they will not be permitted to enter.

Proof of Vaccination must be provided by:

- All patrons/players 18 years of age or older
- All spectators coming to view a game/practice/event who are 12 years of age or older
- All coaches, officials and volunteers who are 12 years of age or older must provide proof of vaccination.

The following exemptions apply:

- Workers, contractors, repair workers, delivery workers, inspectors or others who are entering the arena for work purposes and not as patrons
- A patron who is entering to make a retail purchase or purchase admission
- Children under 12 years of age
- Children aged 12-17 who are entering the arena to participate in a scheduled game/practice, not as a spectator of said game/practice

Appropriate Forms of Identification:

The identification provided must include the patron's name and date of birth. Appropriate forms of identification include:

- Birth Certificate
- Citizenship Card
- Driver's License
- Health Card
- Indian Status Card/Indigenous Membership Card
- Passport
- Permanent Resident Card

****The name and date of birth on the receipt must match the name and date of birth on the piece of identification provided, or the patron cannot enter.**

Please note: All patrons screening, masking, and collection of patron contact information will continue to be required as previously indicated.
